3	(c) For purposes of this subchapter, a political subdivision of the
4	state may elect to not use competitive bidding for other professional
5	services not listed in subsection (b) of this section with a two-thirds (2/3)
6	vote of the political subdivision's governing body.
7	(d)(l) As used in this section, "construction management" means a
8	project delivery method based on an agreement in which a state agency,
9	political subdivision, public school district, or institution of higher
10	education acquires from a construction entity a series of services that
11	include, but are not limited to, design review, scheduling, cost control,
12	value engineering, constructability evaluation, preparation and coordination
13	of bid packages, and construction administration.
14	(2) "Construction management" includes, but is not limited to:
15	(A)(i) "Agency construction management", in which a public
16	school district selects a construction manager to serve as an agent for the
17	purpose of providing administration and management services.
18	(ii) The construction manager shall not hold
19	subcontracts for the project or provide project bonding for the project;
20	(B) "At-risk construction management", in which the
21	construction entity, after providing agency services during the
22	preconstruction period, serves as the general contractor and the following
23	conditions are met:
24	(i) The construction manager provides a maximum
25	guaranteed price;
26	(ii) The public school district holds all trade
27	contracts and purchase orders; and
28	(iii) The portion of the project not covered by the
29	trade contracts is bonded and guaranteed by the construction manager; and
30	(C)(i) "General contractor construction management", in
31	which the construction entity, after providing agency services during the
32	preconstruction period, serves as the general contractor.
33	(ii) The general contractor shall hold all trade
34	contracts and purchase orders and shall bond and guarantee the project.
35	(e)<u>(</u>d) As used in this subchapter:

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1	(1) "Political subdivision" means counties, school districts,
2	cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and incorporated
3	towns; and
4	(2) "Other professional services" means professional services
5	not listed in subsection (b) of this section as defined by a political
6	subdivision with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its governing body.
