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    of bid packages, and construction administration.

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                       (A)(i) "Agency construction management", in which a public
    school district selects a construction manager to serve as an agent for the
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    purpose of providing administration and management services.
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                             (ii) The construction manager shall not hold
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     subcontracts for the project or provide project bonding for the project;
                       (B) "At-risk construction management", in which the
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    construction entity, after providing agency services during the
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    preconstruction period, serves as the general contractor and the following
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     conditions are met:
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                            (i) The construction manager provides a maximum
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    guaranteed price;
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                            (ii) The public school district holds all trade
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    contracts and purchase orders; and
                             (iii) The portion of the project not covered by the
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    trade contracts is bonded and guaranteed by the construction manager; and
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                       (C)(i) "General contractor construction management", in
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    which the construction entity, after providing agency services during the
    preconstruction period, serves as the general contractor.
