7 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 TO PROVIDE FOR RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
9 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 1, 2011;  
10 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF  
11 THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,  
12 APRIL 27, 2011; TO AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO  
13 TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF  
14 REPRESENTATIVES, BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE  
15 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON,  
16 APRIL 27, 2011, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING  
17 VETOES, CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING  
18 ITS WORK ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS,  
19 COMPLETING ITS WORK ON REAPPORTIONMENT, AND  
20 CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE  
21 REGULAR SESSION OR TO ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH  
22 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY  
23 DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO RECONVENE; TO  
24 PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT  
25 RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, APRIL 27,  
26 2011, THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH  
27 GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

34 RECESS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
2 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

4 (a) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly of  
5 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, April 27, 2011;

6 (b) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to  
7 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days  
8 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April  
9 1, 2011, to April 27, 2011, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall  
10 be open so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and  
11 the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes  
12 of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

13 (c) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly of  
14 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of  
15 business in each chamber on April 1, 2011, or at such earlier time as may be  
16 agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

17 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President  
18 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

19 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00  
20 noon, April 27, 2011, for the purpose of:

21 (A) Considering vetoes;

22 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;

23 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional  
24 amendments; and

25 (D) Completing its work on reapportionment; and

26 (E) Considering the need for further extension of the  
27 Regular Session of the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly; or

28 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-Eighth General  
29 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, April 27, 2011, if they determine it  
30 is not necessary to reconvene; and

31 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before  
32 12:00 noon, April 27, 2011, the Regular Session of the Eighty-Eighth General  
33 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
