20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
21	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
22	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

24	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
25	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
26	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
27	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
28	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of

31	SECTION 1. Section 14(b) of Article 19 of the Arkansas Constitution,

35	enrolled in public and private non-profit two-year and four-year colleges and

2	(2) The remaining lottery proceeds, after the scholarships have
3	been funded, Lottery proceeds shall be used solely to pay the operating
4	expenses of lotteries, including all prizes, and to fund or provide for
5	scholarships and grants to citizens of this State enrolled in public and
6	private non-profit two-year and four-year colleges and universities located
7	within the State that are certified according to criteria established by the
8	General Assembly.
9	(3) The General Assembly shall establish criteria to determine
10	who is eligible to receive the scholarships and grants pursuant to this
11	Amendment amendment.
