20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
22 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
26 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
27 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

29 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
31 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
32 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
33 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
34 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

36 SECTION 1. Section 14(b) of Article 19 of the Arkansas Constitution,



1 concerning the use of the lottery proceeds, is amended to read as follows:

2 (b)(1) At least thirty-five percent (35%) of the total lottery
3 proceeds shall be used to fund or provide scholarships and grants to citizens
4 of this state enrolled in public and private non-profit two-year and four-
5 year colleges and universities located within the state that are certified
6 according to criteria established by the General Assembly.

7 (2) The remaining lottery proceeds, after the scholarships have
8 been funded, Lottery proceeds shall be used solely to pay the operating
9 expenses of lotteries, including all prizes, and to fund or provide for
10 scholarships and grants to citizens of this State enrolled in public and
11 private non-profit two-year and four-year colleges and universities located
12 within the State that are certified according to criteria established by the
13 General Assembly.

14 (3) The General Assembly shall establish criteria to determine
15 who is eligible to receive the scholarships and grants pursuant to this
16 Amendment amendment.
