19	WHEREAS, throughout the history of the United States, a few great
20	leaders have stood the test of time and continued to shape future generations
21	of Americans; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, President Reagan stands as one of the most influential
24	presidents of our great nation, leaving a lasting legacy on American
25	politics, diplomacy, culture, and economics; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, as a boy, President Reagan's father nicknamed him "Dutch" due
28	to his little Dutchman-like appearance and his "Dutchboy" haircut; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, President Ronald Reagan appeared in more than fifty movie
31	roles, served as the spokesperson for General Electric, and served as the
32	thirty-third Governor of the State of California; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, President Regan was elected President of the United States in
35	1980 and overwhelmingly re-elected by winning forty-nine of the fifty states
36	in 1984, carrying Arkansas in both elections: and

2	WHEREAS, President Reagan's defense policies brought about the demise
3	of the Soviet Union, opening the gate to freedom for hundreds of millions of
4	people around the world; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, President Reagan was known for his sense of humor, and above
7	all else, his ability to communicate, earning him the title as "The Great
8	Communicator"; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, when President Reagan finally succumbed to illness on June 5,
11	2004, at the age of 93, the nation mourned the passing of a great leader; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, in honor of the centennial anniversary of his birth, the
14	General Assembly should join all ninety-nine state legislative chambers to
15	introduce and adopt resolutions declaring February 6, 2011, "Ronald Reagan
16	Day",

18	NOW THEREFORE,
19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
20	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
