23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
24	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	WHEREAS, Twenty percent (20%) of Arkansas's economy is based on food,
27	fiber, and forestry; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, Two-thirds (2/3) of Arkansas's counties rely heavily on
30	farming and forestry as their industrial base; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, Agriculture and related activities and industries employ one
33	(1) in every six (6) Arkansans; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, Agricultural pursuits in this state generate a value in excess
36	of sixteen billion dollars (\$16,000,000,000) annually which contributes to



1	Arkansas's stable and well-balanced economy; and
2	
3	WHEREAS, Farmers, ranchers, and foresters provide the bulk of the
4	state's wildlife habitat, practice sound environmental stewardship, and
5	supply community leadership throughout rural Arkansas; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, The agricultural community contributes a substantial portion
8	of the revenues which finance state and local services to all this state's
9	citizens; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers, ranchers, and foresters are deserving of
12	public commendation and appreciation,
13	
14	NOW THEREFORE,
15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
16	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	THAT the Arkansas House of Representatives expresses sincere
19	appreciation to Arkansas farmers for their outstanding contributions to the
20	economy of the state and nation and to the well-being of the people and
21	commends them for their dedication to the wise utilization of our resources
