DISBURSING OFFICER. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the 3 4 Legislative Council shall be the disbursing officer for the funds 5 appropriated by this Act, including the Interim Committee Study Expenses. The 6 Director shall appoint a designee who shall serve as the disbursing officer 7 in his/her absence. In the event there is no Director, the Co-Chairs of the 8 Arkansas Legislative Council can appoint a disbursing officer.  - SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
