WHOM SMOKING IS PROHIBITED IN MOTOR

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-27-1903 is amended to read as follows:
20-27-1903. Tobacco use – Prohibitions.*

*~~Effective July 21, 2006, smoking~~ Smoking is prohibited in any motor
vehicle in which a child who is less than ~~six (6)~~ fourteen (14) years of age
~~and who weighs less than sixty pounds (60 lbs.) is restrained in a child~~
~~passenger safety seat properly secured to the motor vehicle in accordance~~
~~with The Child Passenger Protection Act, § 27-34-101 et seq~~ is a passenger.*
