11 TRAINING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,  
12 2012; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

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15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON LAW  
16 ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING  
17 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL  
18 YEAR.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2011-  
26 2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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18 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

19 appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and

20 Training, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for

21 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law

22 Enforcement Standards and Training - State Operations for the fiscal year

23 ending June 30, 2012, the following:

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - SPECIAL TRAINING - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, for operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Special Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the following:

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2010~~ 2012, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2011~~ 2013.

Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

(1) Prior to June 30, ~~2010~~ 2012, the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

(2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal year to the

1 second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source and a  
2 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

3 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written  
4 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
5 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written  
6 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for  
7 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)  
8 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents  
9 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget  
10 Committee; and

11 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include  
12 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a  
13 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.  
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15 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
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25 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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34 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
36 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.

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
