(6) "Vaccination against rabies" means the injection, subcutaneously or otherwise, of canine antirabic vaccine, as approved by the United States Department of Agriculture or the State Board of Health and administered by a licensed veterinarian or agent of the Department of Health. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-19-305 is amended to read as follows: 20-19-305. Vaccination for dogs and cats, cats, and other animals required. All dogs and cats, cats, and other animals shall be vaccinated against rabies annually or as required by the State Board of Health. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-19-312 is amended to read as follows: 20-19-312. State Board of Health's authority to regulate. (a) The State Board of Health shall promulgate such rules and regulations as are adopt rules necessary to carry out the purposes or provisions of this subchapter, with subsequent amendments as needed. (b) The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission may adopt rules as are necessary pertaining to dogs and cats transported or moved into Arkansas for any purpose.
