8	shall be the prevailing regulations of each reciprocal system;		
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10	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
11	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
12	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System are in urgent need of revision to bring		
13	them into compliance with sound public pension policy; that this revision is		
14	of great importance to members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and		
15	to other citizens of the State of Arkansas; that the Arkansas Teacher		
16	Retirement System should provide credit for employees whose public employer		
17	did not offer mandatory employer contributions before 1985 to prevent undue		
18	harm to members; and that this act is immediately necessary because allowing		
19	members to lose potential service credit for their public service is poor		
20	public policy. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act		
21	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,		
22	and safety shall become effective on:		
23	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
24	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
25	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
26	bill; or		
27	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
28	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
