Arkansas Code § 24-4-101(11), concerning the definition of 13 14 "compensation" under the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 (11)(A) "Compensation" means the recurring remuneration paid a 17 member by public employers for personal services rendered by a member in a 18 position covered by an employer participating in the Arkansas Public 19 Employees' Retirement System. 20 The following shall be considered are recurring 21 remuneration for personal services for the purposes of determining retirement 22 benefits: 23 (i) Career service recognition payments paid to a 24 member under § 21-5-106; 25 (ii) Payments made to a member under § 21-5-1101, 26 including without limitation a lump-sum payment; 27 (iii)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (11)(B)(iii)(b) of this section, payments made to a member under § 14-14-28 29 1206(a), including without limitation a bonus or lump-sum payment. 30 (b) The maximum amount of the bonus or lump-31 sum payment that will be considered to be compensation during the last year 32 of a member's employment is the lesser of five percent (5%) of the current 33 year's salary or the amount of the bonus or lump-sum payment that was 34 received by the member during the previous year of employment; 35 (iv)(a) Except as provided in subdivision

(11)(B)(iv)(b) of this section, a bonus or lump-sum payment made to a

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- 1 municipal employee as provided in the municipality's annual budget under §

- 3 (b) The maximum amount of the bonus or lump-

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- 19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-4-1102(a), concerning member
- 20 contributions to the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 (a)(1) The contributions of a member shall be five percent (5%) of the
- 23 member's annual compensation and shall be placed in the member's deposit
- 24 account as provided in § 24-4-401.
- 25 (2) Interest shall be paid on accumulated member contributions
- 26 at the rate of four percent (4%) per annum.
- 27 (3) As used in this subsection, "compensation" has the same
- 28 meaning as in § 24-4-101.

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- 30 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
- 31 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Public Employees'
- 32 Retirement System currently requires that retirement contributions be based
- on a member's base salary plus any multipliers; that retirement contributions
- 34 and benefits should be determined based on a member's base salary and not any
- 35 multipliers or special salary allowances; and that this act is immediately
- 36 <u>necessary to clarify the meaning of the term "compensation" for purposes of</u>

1	the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is		
2	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the		
3	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
4	<u>on:</u>		
5	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
6	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
7	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
8	bill; or		
9	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
10	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
