20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
23 established for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission – State Operations
24 for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular
25 employees.

26 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE. There is hereby
27 authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Trial Public
28 Defender Office for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number
29 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
30 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or
31 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
32 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
33 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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35 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE. There is
36 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be

33 SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM. There is hereby
 34 appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from
 35 the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Arkansas Public
 36 Defender Commission - Ombudsman Program for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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9 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
11 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - COURTS. Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code
12 §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 the monies collected by the courts
13 under the authority of §5-4-303(g) and 16-87-213 shall be deposited into the
14 State Treasury to the credit of the State Central Services Fund.

15 In the event that the law requires that the fees levied under §5-4-303(g)
16 be deposited into the State Administration of Justice Fund, the State
17 Treasurer shall transfer the amount of the fees collected each month under
18 the authority of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) from the State Administration of
19 Justice Fund to the State Central Services Fund.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
21 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

23 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
25 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - BAIL BOND FEES. Unless specified otherwise in
26 Arkansas Code §17-19-301(e) the monies collected by each bail bond company
27 under the authority of §17-19-301(e) shall be deposited into the State
28 Treasury to the credit of the Public Defender User Fees Fund within the State
29 Central Services Fund.

30 Of the fee collected by each licensed professional bail bond company, three
31 dollars (\$3.00) shall be transferred to the various Counties for the sole
32 purpose of defraying the operating expenses of the local public defenders'
33 office. The remaining monies collected shall be used to defray operating
34 expenses of the Commission.

35 On a quarterly basis, from the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item,
36 the Commission shall remit to each County its portion of the three dollars

1 (\$3.00) per bail bond fee collected based upon the formula used for state aid
 2 for counties. This formula is as follows: 75% of the money is distributed
 3 equally to all 75 Counties and the remaining 25% is distributed per capita.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 5 ~~2010~~ 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

 7 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 9 PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the
 10 appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient,
 11 appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program
 12 line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving
 13 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
 15 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

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 17 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUTIES OF
 19 DEPENDENCY-NEGLECT APPEALS ATTORNEY. The Public Defender Commission shall
 20 utilize Dependency-Neglect Appeals Attorneys exclusively to write appeals in
 21 dependency-neglect cases.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
 23 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

 25 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC
 27 DEFENDERS. (a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in
 28 cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel where retained
 29 counsel ~~who~~ have not gone through the Public Defender Commission's attorney
 30 certification procedure ~~qualification~~ and designation process as established
 31 by state law and the Commission's regulations. All defendants and retained
 32 attorneys must strictly adhere to the procedure established by the Commission
 33 to equitably and responsibly monitor and distribute State funds for this
 34 purpose.

35 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection (a)
 36 as needed. Reasons for granting exemption should be specified in writing.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
2 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

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4 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
25 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
