14	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
15	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEASING		
16	FROM ARKANSAS BUILDING AUTHORITY. The Board of Hearing Instrument Dispensers		
17	shall be exempt from Arkansas Building Authority leasing jurisdiction and		
18	procedures as set out in Arkansas Code 22-2-114.		
19	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -2010		
20	<u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u> .

22	SECTION 4. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in		
23	this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment		
24	for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in		
25	writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the		
26	required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the		
27	requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall		
28	determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the		
29	requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the		
30	agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend		
31	monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:		
32	(1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that		
33	such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and		

Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of

(2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the

legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

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the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
