11 DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 AN EMERGENCY.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-211(d)(2), concerning the Arkansas
24 Policemen's Pension Supplement Program, is amended to read as follows:

25 (2) A retired police officer or a survivor currently receiving
26 retirement benefits from a local policemen's pension and relief fund of four
27 hundred dollars (\$400) or more per month shall receive a supplement under the
28 program of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred dollars (\$100) per month.
29

30 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
31 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that police officers put their
32 lives on the line to protect the citizens of their communities; that the cost
33 of living has increased; that the fiscal year for retirement systems begins
34 July 1, 2011; and that police officers are in dire need of additional
35 retirement benefits. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
36 act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and



1 safety shall become effective on July 1, 2011.
