1	(d) The license shall remain suspended until:		
2	(1) The company can post an additional certificate of deposit or		
3	letter of credit with the board so that the company's security deposit		
4	exceeds the unpaid bond forfeiture or forfeitures amount;		
5	(2) The bond forfeiture judgment or judgments are paid to the		
6	extent that the total amount of unpaid forfeiture or forfeitures are less		
7	than the security deposit posted with the board; or		
8	(3)(A) The court that entered the bond forfeiture judgment		
9	releases the company's security deposit from responsibility on the unpaid		
10	forfeiture as required by § 17-19-208 (a)(1).		
11	(B) If the court releases the company's security deposit		
12	from responsibility on an unpaid bond forfeiture judgment, the release must		
13	be decreed by court order.		
14	(e) If the court releases the company's security deposit from		
15	liability on a bond forfeiture, that bond amount shall not count against the		
16	company's unpaid forfeiture limit.		
17	(f) A company's unpaid bond forfeiture limit shall not exceed one		
18	hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) unless the company has posted additional		
19	security with the board and shall never exceed the company's total amount of		
20	posted security deposit or one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), whichever		
21	<u>is more.</u>
