SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 18 OF FUNDS. Arkansas Building Authority may from time to time as may be 19 necessary and in such amounts as may be necessary and with the approval of 20 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, request a transfer of funds from the 21 State Central Services Fund to the Arkansas Building Authority Maintenance 22 Fund for operation of the Justice Building for actual expenditures, in an 23 amount not to exceed the dollar amount appropriated in Section 7. This is usually accomplished by 19 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 20 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 21 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 22 has determined that the Arkansas Building Authority may operate more 23 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Building 24 Authority authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both 25 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 26 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 27 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 29 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 30 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 31 this entire section is void.

TRANSFER 10 TO FACILITIES MANAGEMENT CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. (a) In order to 11 provide a more cost effective method to address the emerging infrastructure 12 needs of Arkansas State Government, appropriations and funds transferred to 13 the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation are to be used in the 14 event that the Arkansas Building Authority executes one or more building 15 contracts or maintenance agreements with State Agencies, and the 16 appropriations or funds otherwise provided for the Arkansas Building 17 Authority are not sufficient to address those needs, and it is more cost 18 effective for the Arkansas Building Authority to execute these services. Any 19 State Agency may transfer or deposit funds and appropriations to the Arkansas 20 Building Authority - Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation 21 authorized in Section 5 of this Act to execute one or more building contracts 22 or maintenance agreements with said State Agencies. The Arkansas Building 23 Authority shall provide justification to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 24 State for the need of such appropriations and funds transfers and seek and 25 receive approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Arkansas Building 26 Authority shall then seek and receive the approval of the Arkansas 27 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The requirement of approval 28 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 29 severable part of the section. If the requirement of approval by the 30 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 31 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 32 void.

33 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
34 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for
35 the transfer or deposit of the funds and appropriations from each State
36 Agency to the appropriation authorized in Section 5 of this Act and to the

6 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - TRANSFER. In the event there is not 8 9 sufficient appropriation and/or funding provided for by the General Assembly 10 for any state agency, board or commission to participate in the Sustainable 11 Building Design Program for renovations of state owned property which exceeds 12 two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), the agency may request a 13 transfer from the Sustainable Building Design Program appropriation 14 authorized in Section 14 of this Act from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 15 State. The request shall clearly state the amount required and such other 16 information as may be required by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State 17 necessary to make a decision regarding the request. Upon approval of the 18 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the Arkansas 19 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be 20 notified as of the amount and the purposes for which the appropriation and/or 21 funding is to be transferred and shall be established upon the books of the 22 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. If desired, 23 the appropriation may be supplemental to those regularly appropriated for 24 like purposes by the General Assembly for that agency.

Provided further, that all state agencies, boards or commissions shall have prior approval by the Arkansas Building Authority as authorized for the Sustainable Building Design Program in accordance with established Rules and Regulations.

30 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 32 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - REVOLVING LOAN FUND. The Sustainable 33 Building Design Program Appropriation is intended to provide additional 34 appropriation authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program. Funding 35 for the program may be made available by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 36 State, in the form of a loan, from a transfer from the Sustainable Building

1 Design Revolving Loan Fund after the required review by the Arkansas 2 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval through rules and regulations established 3 4 and administered by the Arkansas Building Authority. Moneys made available 5 for the repayment of a loan shall be deposited to the credit of the 6 Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund as a "Refund to Expenditure" 7 for the year in which the deposit is made. In the event that the funds for 8 the repayment of a loan are held in depositories other than the State 9 Treasury, the administrative head of the affected state agency shall issue a 10 check drawn against the funds, which shall be deposited in the Sustainable 11 Building Design Revolving Loan Fund.

SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 15 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - RULES AND REGULATIONS. Rules and 16 Regulations shall be established and administered by the Arkansas Building 17 Authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program prior to the 18 implementation of any transfers of appropriation and/or funding. The Rules 19 and Regulations shall be reviewed by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 20 Committee prior to implementation.

22 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 24 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may transfer from time to TRANSFER. 25 time on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of 26 the State funding which is made available from General Improvement Funds 27 allocated and distributed to the Arkansas Building Authority in an amount not 28 to exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from the General Improvement 29 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts to the Sustainable Building 30 Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided 31 herein or for appropriation authority as may be provided by law to provide 32 loans to agencies for the Sustainable Building Design Program. 33

34 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 36 TRANSFER. From time to time, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may

transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) from Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the appropriations herein.

SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING</u> <u>TRANSFER. The Arkansas Building Authority is authorized to transfer any</u> <u>unspent funds remaining in any cash fund account established for the</u> <u>management of a state owned facility managed by, but not owned by, the</u> <u>Arkansas Building Authority to the Arkansas Building Authority Maintenance</u> <u>Fund to support the facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.</u>

15 SECTION 27. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 28. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 33

34 <u>SECTION 29. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u>
 35 <u>General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits</u>
 36 <u>the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the</u>

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1	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
2	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
4	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
5	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
