35	SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED	INTO THE ARKANSAS

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1 CONFERENCES. The funds appropriated herein for Aid to County Veterans' 2 Service Offices may also be used by the Department of Veterans' Affairs to pay expenses of County Veterans' Service Officers for attending regional or 3 4 statewide training conferences approved by the Department of Veterans' 5 Affairs and designed to provide better trained and qualified Veterans' 6 Service Officers in the various counties. Any such expenses paid by the 7 Department of Veterans' Affairs from funds appropriated herein shall be on 8 the same reimbursement basis as the reimbursement of state employees for 9 expenses incurred in attending their official business. Provided, no County 10 Veterans' Service Officer shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for 11 expenses incurred in attending more than two (2) approved conferences per 12 year.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
14 <u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u>.

16 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LIABILITY 18 INSURANCE APPROPRIATION RESTRICTION. In no event shall the Department of 19 Veterans' Affairs expend or transfer any appropriation or funds for the 20 purchase of malpractice liability insurance for the benefit of a non-21 governmental entity.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010 23 <u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u>.

25 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 26 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 28 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

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1 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
2 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
