29	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-1-402(f), concerning registration as a	
30	lobbyist by a former member of the General Assembly, is amended to read as

33	to be registered as a lobbyist under § 21-8-601 et seq. until <u>one (1) year</u>	
34	after the expiration of the term of office for which he or she was elected.

36	elected to the General Assembly on or after the effective date of this act.	

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
