1	(A) Reasonable and necessary expenses for:		
2	(i) Travel;		
3	(ii) Meals; <u>and</u>		
4	(iii) Lodging; and		
5	(B) Other authorized expenses.		
6	(b)(1) A member of the General Assembly may travel to a national or		
7	regional conference by commercial airplane, private vehicle, or other		
8	approved method of transportation.		
9	(2)(A) Reimbursement for out-of-state travel is the lesser rate		
10	of reasonable airfare or the established rate of private car mileage based on		
11	map mileage when driven.		
12	(B) Travel authorized by a chair of a legislative		
13	committee shall also be subject to approval by the Speaker of the House of		
14	Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.		
15	(C) When the Speaker of the House of Representatives or
