(2)(A) A fee shall be charged in an amount to be set by the board for consultations, scientific or medical research, depositions, expert witness testimony, and travel to and from courts. (B) The fees under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section shall be at a rate not to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) two hundred twenty-five dollars (\$225) per hour or six hundred dollars (\$600) one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800) per day and shall be levied against the requesting individual, agency, or organization for work done in civil cases in which laboratory personnel involvement results from the performance of duties and responsibilities under this subchapter; and (3) A charge of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for each autopsy requested by non-law enforcement officials.
