SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 PARK BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative 10 11 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism 12 Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each 13 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this 14 Act. The request for review from the agency shall include amounts to be 15 disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year compared to the 16 current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the previous fiscal year's 17 actual expenditures with any additional detail as may be required by the reviewing body. The Parks and Tourism Department shall also prepare a 18 19 semiannual status report for the reviewing body comparing six-month and 20 fiscal year actual expenditures to intended disbursements reviewed under this 21 Section.

25 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 27 MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act for Parks and 28 Tourism Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval 29 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special 30 maintenance program for the Park System. The funds provided will be used for 31 repair and upkeep of parks and museum facilities that have been deferred due 32 to lack of funds in the individual budgets of the parks and museums. 33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 3 has determined that the Department of Parks and Tourism may operate more 4 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Parks and 5 Tourism authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both 6 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 7 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 8 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 9 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section or 10 the Special Maintenance line item. If the requirement of approval by the 11 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a 12 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section and the Special Maintenance line item in Section 5 is void. 13

1 SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TOURISM ATTRACTION FEASIBILITY GRANT PROGRAM. Of the funds appropriated to the 3 4 Department of Parks and Tourism for grants by Item (05) in Section 3 of this 5 Act, the Department is authorized to make grants to cities and counties on a 6 one to one dollar matching basis, up to \$15,000 in state funds per grant, for 7 the purpose of feasibility studies for tourism attractions.
