13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - GENERAL
21 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
22 Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
23 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for repairs, technology,
26 training, infrastructure needs and expenses for county hospitals, in a sum
27 not to exceed.....\$10,000.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 291 of 2010, for a grant to an organization for
30 training, job readiness, and adult literacy services of former prisoners to
31 be re-introduced into society, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,750.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 291 of 2010, for a grant to an organization for
34 youth summer employment programs for tutoring, mentoring, educational,
35 social, recreational, personal services and operating expenses, in a sum not
36 to exceed.....\$3,750.



1 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 291 of 2010, for a grant to a domestic violence
3 shelter for crisis intervention, safe shelter, support services, personal
4 services and operating expenses, and social and legal advocacy services, in a
5 sum not to exceed.....\$5,000.

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7 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES -
8 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
9 Human Services - Division of Administrative Services, to be payable from the
10 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
11 Department of Human Services - Division of Administrative Services the
12 following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 291 of 2010, for various maintenance,
15 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
16 repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-
17 wide, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,907,935.

18 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 291 of 2010, for maintenance, renovation,
20 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair
21 projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-wide, in
22 a sum not to exceed.....\$9,185,422.

23 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants and assistance to
25 community organizations for maintenance and general operations, personal
26 services, and construction expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$118,500.

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28 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF AGING AND ADULT SERVICES -
29 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
30 Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services, to be payable from the
31 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
32 Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services the
33 following:

34 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
36 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,

1 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
2\$31,250.

3 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (B) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
5 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
6 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
7\$20,000.

8 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (C) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for a grant for hospice providers
10 for construction, renovation, personal services, operating, purchase of
11 equipment, and major maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed
12\$10,789.

13 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (D) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
15 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
16 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
17\$10,000.

18 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (E) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
20 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
21 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
22\$12,500.

23 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (F) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for personal services
25 and operating expenses, construction, renovation, and the purchase of
26 equipment to older Arkansan services providers to provide various community-
27 based senior services, including but not limited to, congregate and home-
28 delivered meals, client representation, information and assistance,
29 socialization, adult day care and transportation, in a sum not to exceed
30\$15,000.

31 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (G) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
33 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
34 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
35\$30,000.

36 (H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (H) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for a pilot program for the
2 Arkansas Area Agency on Aging to serve week-end frozen home delivered meals
3 to eligible recipients in Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,000.

4 (I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (I) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to Area Agencies on
6 Aging for construction, renovation, personal services and operating expenses,
7 purchase of equipment, and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a
8 sum not to exceed.....\$28,750.

9 (J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (J) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
11 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
12 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
13\$35,000.

14 (K) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (K) Section 3 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for construction,
16 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
17 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
18\$6,250.

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20 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH - DRUG ABUSE
21 PREVENTION AND TREATMENT FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Department of Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health, to be payable
23 from the Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment Fund, for the Department of
24 Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (H) Section 4 of Act 291 of 2010, for behavioral health services to
27 the citizens of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$17,501.
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29 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH - GENERAL
30 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
31 Services - Division of Behavioral Health, to be payable from the General
32 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department
33 of Human Services - Division of Behavioral Health the following:

34 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for the research, training,
36 development for mental health, and operating expenses of mental health

1 centers, in a sum not to exceed.....\$16,429.

2 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (B) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for a grant for Community Mental
4 Health Centers for uncompensated care, in a sum not to exceed.....\$21,036.

5 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (F) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for maintenance, personal services
7 and operating expenses for grants for prevention and treatment programs,
8 community programs serving disabled individuals, and other community
9 development programs, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,125.

10 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (G) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to Alcohol and Substance
12 Abuse Prevention and Treatment Programs and Prevention Resource Centers for
13 personal services and operating expenses, construction, improvements,
14 equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed
15\$3,008.

16 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (H) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to domestic violence and
18 rape crisis centers for personal services and operating expenses,
19 construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses,
20 in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,750.

21 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (L) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for drug and alcohol
23 addiction prevention and Prevention Resource Centers for personal services
24 and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and
25 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$12,500.

26 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (M) Section 6 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to Alcohol Abuse
28 Rehabilitation and Treatment Centers for personal services and operating
29 expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and maintenance
30 expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,000.

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32 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF CHILD CARE AND EARLY CHILDHOOD
33 ED - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
34 Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education, to be
35 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
36 accounts, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and

1 Early Childhood Education the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants for personal services
4 and operating expenses of after school programs for low income and rural
5 school districts providing early childhood development, literacy, physical
6 activity, nutrition, and emergency relief programs for children in Arkansas,
7 in a sum not to exceed.....\$35,500.

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9 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES -
10 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
11 Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services, to be
12 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
13 accounts, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental
14 Disabilities Services the following:

15 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (A) Section 8 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to community programs
17 serving developmentally disabled individuals for personal services and
18 operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
19 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$52,062.

20 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
21 in Item (B) Section 8 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to community programs
22 serving developmentally disabled individuals for personal services and
23 operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
24 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

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26 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES - YOUTH
27 SERVICES FACILITIES NEEDS FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the
28 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services, to be payable from
29 the Department of Human Services - Youth Services Facilities Needs Fund, for
30 the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services the following:

31 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (A) Section 10 of Act 291 of 2010, for purchase of needed equipment,
33 acquisition of facilities, repairs or renovations, contracting with providers
34 for services, construction expenses, or other facility operations costs, in a
35 sum not to exceed.....\$21,857.

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1 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES - GENERAL
2 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
3 Services - Division of Youth Services, to be payable from the General
4 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department
5 of Human Services - Division of Youth Services the following:

6 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (B) Section 11 of Act 291 of 2010, for grants to community based
8 programs and juvenile delinquency prevention programs for personal services
9 and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
10 and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$12,500.
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12 SECTION 10. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
13 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
14 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
15 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
16 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
17 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
18 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
19 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
20 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
21 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
22 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
23 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

24 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
25 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
26 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
27 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
28 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
29 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
30 otherwise by law.
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32 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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5 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
7 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that previous
8 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or
9 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the
10 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,
11 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the
12 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.
13 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
14 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
15 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.

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
