26 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 27-50-27 1201 is amended to read as follows:

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27-50-1201. Applicability.

29 (a) The provisions of this subchapter <u>This subchapter</u> shall apply to
30 any person, firm, organization, or other entity <u>applies to a person:</u>

31 <u>(1) engaged Engaged</u> in the towing or storage of vehicles in the
32 State of Arkansas; and

33 <u>(2) That is hired to tow or store the vehicle</u>.

34 (b) The provisions of this subchapter shall This subchapter does not
35 apply to the following tow vehicles and related equipment:

36 (1) Car carriers capable of carrying five (5) or more vehicles

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1 and which that have federal Interstate Commerce Commission authority; 2 (2) Tow vehicles owned by a governmental entity and not used for 3 commercial purposes; and 4 (3) Tow If in compliance with § 27-35-112, tow vehicles that 5 are: 6 (A) registered Registered in another state; 7 (B) operating Operating under federal Interstate Commerce 8 Commission authority; and 9 (C) which do not regularly do business or solicit Not 10 regularly doing business or soliciting business in the State of Arkansas. 11 However, any tow vehicle for which this exemption is claimed must be in 12 compliance with § 27-35-112. 13 14 SECTION 5. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 15 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 16 17 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 18 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 19 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 20 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 21 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 22 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 23 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if: 24 The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that (1)25 such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and 26 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 27 legal counsel to be retained by the agency. 28 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of 29 the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 30 31 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and 32 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes. 33 34 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16

17 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 21 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 28 29 /s/Joint Budget Committee 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
