## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES FROM THE STATE CRIME
LABORATORY BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REMOVE THE DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES FROM THE STATE CRIME LABORATORY BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-302(a) and (b), concerning the composition of the State Crime Laboratory Board, are amended to read as follows:
(a) (1) There is created a State Crime Laboratory Board to be composed of eight ( 8 ) members.
(2) (A) The Dean of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, College of Medicine, shall sexve as a member. The femaining seven (7) members of the board shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate.
(B) However, a vacancy may be temporarily filled by the Governor until the Senate shall next meet.
(b) The members appointed by the Governor shall be composed of:
(1) One (l) member of the active judiciary;
(2) One (1) practicing member of the legal profession;
(3) One (1) active county sheriff;
(4) One (1) active chief of police;
(5) One (1) active prosecuting attorney;
(6) One (1) physician Two (2) physicians engaged in the active practice of private or academic medicine; and
(7) One (1) member at large from the state.
