Provided that no funds shall be expended to fund the positions of 3 Chancellor, Dean of Medicine and any academic position until the Chancellor 4 and Dean of Medicine certify to the Arkansas Legislative Council that the 5 provision of this Section relating to the fiscal year requirement for one 6 hundred fifty (150) freshman student admissions has been implemented. 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 8 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012. 9 10 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHAPLAIN HOUSING ALLOWANCE. The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical 12 Sciences may designate up to forty-five percent (45%) of the regular gross 13
- appointed as a Chaplain Resident, as a housing allowance, to the extent used by the person to rent or provide a home, according to the guidelines of the

salary (or stipend) of a minister or other clergy employed as a Chaplain or

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 20 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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SECTION 34. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INDIGENT 24 CARE REIMBURSEMENT. The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is 25 hereby authorized to utilize funds appropriated by this Act to extend 26 provisions of Act 688 of 1989 to authorize procedures for the disbursement of 27 Indigent Care maintenance and general operations appropriations to be paid from cash funds of the institution, subject to reimbursement and correction 28 29 of reporting, as provided by Arkansas Code 19-4-1609.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 31 $\frac{2010}{2011}$ through June 30, $\frac{2011}{2012}$.

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SECTION 35. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

ESTABLISHMENT OF A "GROWTH POOL". (a) The Arkansas Department of Higher

36 Education shall establish and maintain for the 2010-2011 2011-2012 fiscal

- 1 year a pool of three hundred (300) nonclassified positions at a salary level
- 2 not to exceed \$293,550. These positions are to be used by the University of
- 3 Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal services needs
- 4 of the University during the 2010 2011 2011-2012 fiscal year exceed the
- 5 number of positions allocated to the University by the Legislature. The
- 6 University shall provide justification to the Arkansas Department of Higher
- 7 Education for the need to allocate titles from this "growth pool". No
- 8 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific
- 9 positions are requested by the University, approved by the University Board
- 10 or their designee, and approved by the Legislative Council. Furthermore, the
- 11 Office of Personnel Management (OPM) of the Division of Management Services
- 12 of the Department of Finance and Administration shall establish and maintain
- 13 for the $\frac{2010-2011}{2011-2012}$ 2011-2012 fiscal year a pool of three hundred (300) career

- 21 positions are requested by the University, recommended by OPM, and approved
- 22 by the Legislative Council.
- 23 (b) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
- 24 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
- 25 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying the job titles and
- 26 the maximum grade or salary attached to those salaries. The General Assembly
- 27 has determined that the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences could be
- 28 operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution.
- 29 That flexibility is being accomplished by providing growth pools in
- 30 subsection (a) of this section and since the General Assembly has granted the
- 31 institution broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary
- 32 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the
- 33 utilization of the growth pool by requiring prior approval of the Legislative
- 34 Council in the utilization of the growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of

- 9 SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHILD AND
- 11 FAMILY LIFE INSTITUTE. The Child Health and Family Life Institute shall be
- 12 administered under the direction of Arkansas Children's Hospital. Arkansas
- 13 Children's Hospital shall enter into a cooperative agreement and/or contract
- 14 with the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences-Department of Pediatrics
- 15 for services required to deliver the programs of the Child Health and Family

- 30 SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARKING
- 32 FEES. On July 1 of each year the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences
- 33 shall pay from the appropriation provided herein from non-general revenue,
- 34 the total amount appropriated for War Memorial Stadium Commission Parking
- 35 Services from Fees to the War Memorial Stadium Commission.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010

1 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Because the Rural Medical Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Program Loans and/or Scholarships and the Community Match Student Loan and Scholarship Program Loans and/or Scholarships have the goal of providing primary care physicians in rural Arkansas, transfers may be made in such amounts as are required between the line items made in the appropriation for "Medical Loans and Scholarships".

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{1}$ 2011 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{1}$ 2012.

SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLINICAL EXPANSION AND RESEARCH POOL. (a) In order to address personnel needs emerging from expanding medical research and patient care issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified medical, research, and related support personnel, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences or its successor is authorized for the 2010-2011 2011-2012 fiscal year a pool of one thousand five hundred (1,500) "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions. These positions are to be used by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal services needs resulting from unanticipated clinical or research programs that are initiated during the 2010-2011 2011-2012 fiscal year require additional positions, either in title, in classification, or in number, that are not authorized or contemplated by the General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act.

These "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions may also be used to properly classify positions when the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences does not have a vacant position available with the appropriate title, grade, or salary level. The salary rates for these positions shall not exceed the highest maximum annual salary rate or the highest grade level position authorized by the General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act, as governed by the uniform Classification and Compensation Act of 1969, §21-5-201 et seq., or its successor.

(b) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is authorized to

- 1 access the "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions authorized in
- 2 this Section at any time during the fiscal year when it is determined by the
- 3 Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, subject to the
- 4 review and approval by the Board of Trustees, that the need for additional
- 5 positions exists. The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical
- 6 Sciences shall provide a quarterly report detailing the justification of
- 7 allocation of positions from this "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" to
- 8 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to the Department of Higher Education,
- 9 and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee for review.
- 10 The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles and salaries
- 11 of personnel who have been employed in positions established from this pool
- 12 and the source and duration of funds associated with the positions.
- 13 (c) If the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences requests
- 14 continuation of any "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" position(s) as
- 15 established herein during the next fiscal year, the position(s) must be
- 16 requested as a new position(s) in the agency's budget request.
- 17 (d) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state
- 18 agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished
- 19 by delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and
- 20 the maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly
- 21 has determined that the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences could be
- 22 operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution.
- 23 That flexibility is being accomplished by providing a position pool in
- 24 Subsection (a) of this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the
- 25 agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and
- 26 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization
- 27 of the position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council or Joint
- 28 Budget Committee in the utilization of the position pool. Therefore, the
- 29 requirement of review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is
- 30 not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of review by the
- 31 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
- 32 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

SECTION 40. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 6 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 7 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 8 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 9 with in disbursement of said funds. 10 11 SECTION 41. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 13 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 19 20 SECTION 42. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 22 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 25 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 26 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 28 29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 30 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 31 32 33 34 35
