SECTION 17. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES AND THE ARTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) for construction, renovations, major maintenance, maintenance, furnishings, and purchase of equipment for the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts, in a sum not to exceed  
 .....\$4,000,000.

SECTION 18. APPROPRIATION - ELECTRICAL ENERGY ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the Electrical Energy Advancement Program Fund, for competitive scholarships and graduate fellowships, project costs, and collaborative

1 *research projects of institutions of higher education as determined by the*  
 2 *Arkansas Statewide Energy Consortium in compliance with Arkansas Law, of the*  
 3 *University of Arkansas – National Center for Reliable Electric Power*  
 4 *Transmission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the sum of*  
 5 *.....\$800,000.*

6  
 7 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WINTHROP  
 9 ROCKEFELLER INSTITUTE FUNDING. The University of Arkansas shall allocate and  
 10 budget and commit for expenditure \$108,098 to fund the appropriation  
 11 authorized from general revenue for the Winthrop Rockefeller Institute as  
 12 appropriated in Section 16 herein.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
 14 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

15  
 16 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CRIMINAL  
 18 JUSTICE INSTITUTE TRANSFER PROVISION. Immediately upon the effective date of  
 19 this Act the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, Treasurer of State and  
 20 Auditor of State shall transfer on their books the sum of one hundred fifty  
 21 thousand dollars (\$150,000) from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund to  
 22 the University of Arkansas Fund for allocation to the Criminal Justice  
 23 Institute for education and training to assist the criminal justice community  
 24 in addressing the clandestine methamphetamine activities in the State.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
 26 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

27  
 28 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
 30 ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY USE AND DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under  
 31 Section 3 and allocated in Item (5) of Section 4 of this Act are to be used  
 32 for the personal services and maintenance and general operation of the  
 33 Arkansas Archeological Survey and for no other purpose. The Vice-President  
 34 for Finance and Administration of the University of Arkansas is hereby made  
 35 the disbursing officer for the appropriation made by this Act.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~

1 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

3 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
5 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing  
6 and other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of the athletic  
7 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches,  
8 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head  
9 trainers in the ~~men's and women's~~ Athletic Departments at the University of  
10 Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances  
11 available therefore in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as  
12 justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties  
13 of said athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head  
14 coaches, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators,  
15 and head trainers in the ~~men's and women's~~ Athletic Departments at the  
16 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such  
17 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary  
18 income of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from  
19 athletic event receipts, or from contributions from sources other than state  
20 funds, an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such  
21 purposes during each fiscal year for the athletic directors, associate  
22 athletic directors, and head coaches, and an amount not to exceed one  
23 thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant athletic directors,  
24 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head  
25 trainers. Any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of  
26 such athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head  
27 coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the special allowance funds  
28 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall  
29 report annually to the Arkansas Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the  
30 exact disposition of those special allowance funds. In recognition of the  
31 extra work involved in the participation of intercollegiate athletic teams in  
32 post-season competition, and to promote exceptional achievement in the total  
33 sports program, the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville,  
34 in accordance with policies issued by the Board of Trustees of the University  
35 of Arkansas, may approve additional compensation of up to one month's salary  
36 for the Athletic Department and Band personnel when any athletic team

1 participates in post-season competition or achieves exceptional recognition,  
2 which shall be in addition to the regular salaries authorized by law,  
3 provided that the additional compensation shall be paid from contributions  
4 from sources other than public funds.

8 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
10 ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of  
11 Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head and  
12 assistant coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, from revenues  
13 generated by contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes, multimedia  
14 rights, and other products in such amounts as may be established by the Board  
15 of Trustees for performance by the coaches of consulting and other  
16 obligations pursuant to contracts between the University and such vendors.  
17 Such additional payments to head and assistant coaches shall not be  
18 considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum  
19 salaries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. Nothing in  
20 this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted  
21 elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to  
22 coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
24 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

25  
26 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
28 APPRENTICE PROGRAM WAGES. All apprentices in the University of Arkansas U.S.  
29 Department of Labor Approved Apprentices Program shall be appointed into the  
30 State of Arkansas Classified Pay Plan title of (C105) Apprentice Tradesman at  
31 the then Labor Market Entry Rate.

32 Using successive Arkansas Department of Labor Prevailing Wage  
33 Determination (ADLPWD) Building Rates for Washington County for the craft  
34 title matching that Apprentice's craft training, individual Apprentices shall  
35 be paid progressively increasing wages upon successful completion of  
36 successive years of training for their craft. Progressively increasing, as

1 strongly encouraged for this type program by the U.S. Department of Labor, is  
2 defined as a percentage difference between the Apprentice's current salary  
3 and the next year's ADLPWD Washington County Building Rates Basic Hourly Rate  
4 for their chosen craft, but not less than the preceding year's wages with any  
5 authorized cost of living (COLA) applied.

6 Upon successful completion of the Apprentice Program, fulfillment of  
7 all related licensing requirements, and availability of an open Skilled  
8 Trades Worker position (if not already in a C115 Skilled Tradesman position),  
9 all Apprentice Program graduates shall be promoted to a C115 Skilled  
10 Tradesman position and earn the ADLPWD Washington County Building Rates Basic  
11 Hourly Rate for the classification of their chosen craft except that: "No  
12 Apprentice Program graduate shall earn wages less than C115 Skilled Tradesman  
13 Entry Level."

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
15 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

16  
17 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SCHOOL  
19 FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES, AND THE ARTS SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees of  
20 School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts who, in addition to working  
21 during the regular school term also work during the summer months, shall be  
22 authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/10 of their  
23 annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional  
24 compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary  
25 authorized for said employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be  
26 limited to employees as follows:

27 SUMMER PROGRAM POSITIONS

28 Teacher

29 Residential Mentor

30 Counselor

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
32 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

33  
34 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SCHOOL  
36 FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES AND THE ARTS TEACHER GRANT RELATED FUNDING

1 PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts  
2 who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements also  
3 write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be  
4 authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/10 of their  
5 annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as  
6 exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. The additional  
7 compensation authorized by this section shall not be paid from state general  
8 revenues or Educational Excellence Trust Fund monies.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~  
10 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

11  
12 SECTION 27. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
13 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
15 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
18 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
19 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
20 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
21 with in disbursement of said funds.

22  
23 SECTION 28. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31  
32 SECTION 29. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
33 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
34 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of  
36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in



1 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
2 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm  
3 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
4 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
5 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
6 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
