  - (b) It also shall be unlawful for any corporation or voluntary association to solicit itself by or through its officers, agents, or employees any claim or demand for the purpose of bringing an action thereon or of representing as attorney at law or for furnishing legal advice, services, or counsel to a person sued or about to be sued in any action or proceeding or against whom an action or proceeding has been or is about to be brought, or who may be affected by any action or proceeding that has been or may be instituted in any court or before any judicial body, or for the purpose of so representing any person in the pursuit of any civil remedy.
    - (c) The fact that any officer, trustee, director, agent, or employee shall be a duly and regularly admitted attorney at law shall not be held to permit or allow any such corporation or voluntary association to do the acts prohibited in this section nor shall that fact be a defense upon the trial of any of the persons mentioned for a violation of the provisions of this section.
      - (d) This section shall not apply to a:

- 19 <u>(1) For-profit</u> corporation or voluntary association lawfully 20 engaged in:
- 21 <u>(A)</u> the <u>The</u> examination and insuring of titles to real 22 property; or
  - (B) nor shall it prohibit a corporation or a voluntary association from employing Employing an attorney or attorneys in and about its own immediate affairs or in any litigation to which it is or may become a party-; or
  - (2) A nonprofit corporation or voluntary association lawfully engaged in representing or assisting an indigent, poor, or disadvantaged person as a client in a civil or criminal matter.
  - (e)(1) Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to prevent a corporation from furnishing to any person lawfully engaged in the practice of law such information or such clerical services in and about his or her professional work as <u>may be lawful</u>, except for the provisions of this section, <u>may be lawful</u> if at all times the lawyer receiving such information or such services shall maintain full professional and direct responsibility to his or her clients for the information and services so received.

1	(2) However, no corporation shall be permitted to render any		
2	services that cannot lawfully be rendered by a person not admitted to		
3	practice law in this state nor to solicit directly or indirectly professional		
4	employment for a lawyer.		
5	(f)(1) Any corporation or voluntary association violating any of the		
6	provisions of this section shall be guilty of a violation and punished by a		
7	fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than five thousand		
8	dollars (\$5,000).		
9	(2) Every officer, trustee, director, agent, or employee of the		
10	corporation or voluntary association who directly or indirectly engages in		
11	any of the acts prohibited in this section or assists such a corporation or		
12	voluntary association to do such prohibited acts shall be guilty of a		
13	violation and shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred		
14	dollars (\$100) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000).
