## For An Act To Be Entitled

 AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO UPDATE SCHOOL POLICIES WHEN A LAW REGARDING CHILD ABUSE IS AMENDED OR IS ADDED TO THE ARKANSAS CODE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section read as follows:

6-10-124. Updating of school policies.
(a) After each regular, fiscal, or special session of the General Assembly, the board of directors of each public school district in the state shall review the Acts of the General Assembly for that session to determine whether a law regarding child abuse has been amended or has been added to the Arkansas Code.
(b) If a board of directors of a public school district determines that the General Assembly has amended or added to the Arkansas Code a law regarding child abuse, the board of directors shall direct the public school district superintendent to update the school's policies to accord with the new law within sixty (60) days after sine die adjournment of the General
