36	(a) The House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on	



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Education shall file separately or jointly, or both, reports of their
findings and recommendations with the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than September 1
November 1 of each year prior to before the convening of a regular session.

5 (b) For each recommendation the report shall include proposed 6 implementation schedules with timelines, specific steps, agencies and persons 7 responsible, resources needed, and drafts of bills proposing all necessary 8 and recommended legislative changes.

9 (c) The report shall be supplemented as needed to accomplish the 10 purposes of this continuing evaluation.

(d)(1) Before a fiscal session under Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, (d)(1) Before a fiscal session under Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, 5, the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education shall meet, jointly or separately as needed, to review the funding recommendations contained in the most recent report filed under this section.

15 (2) The House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on 16 Education, meeting jointly or separately as needed, also shall review any 17 other matters identified by the House Committee on Education or the Senate 18 Committee on Education that may affect the state's obligation to provide a 19 substantially equal opportunity for an adequate education for all public 20 school students.

21 (3) By September 1 November 1 of the calendar year before the 22 beginning of a fiscal session, if the House Committee on Education and the 23 Senate Committee on Education find that the recommendations in the most 24 recent adequacy evaluation report filed under this section should be amended, 25 the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education, 26 jointly or separately, or both, shall advise in writing the President Pro 27 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of 28 their findings and amendments to the adequacy evaluation report.

29 (e) The House Committee on Education or the Senate Committee on 30 Education, separately or jointly, shall publish a draft of the report 31 required under this section or any amendment or supplement to the report not 32 less than fourteen (14) days before the report, amendment, or supplement is 33 submitted to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the 34 House of Representatives.

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
