20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-23-304(c)(1), concerning requirements for		
21	open-enrollment charter schools, is amended to read as follows:		
22	(c)(l) <u>(A)</u> The Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, the state		
23	board may grant no more than a total of twenty-four (24) charters for open-		
24	enrollment public charter schools except as provided under subdivision
