The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may 3 4 establish reasonable rules and regulations to be followed by: 5 (1) Wineries wineries in this state in making application for 6 the subsidy payments and to prevent abuse of the subsidy payments; and 7 (2) Public institutions of higher education in Arkansas with a 8 viticulture and enology program in making application for a grant. 9 10 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 3-5-905 is amended to read as follows: 11 3-5-905. Applications. 12 (a) Any A winery in this state that produces wine from grapes, fruits, 13 berries, or vegetables grown in this state and complies with the provisions 14 of § 3-5-904, that desires to receive the grants authorized in this 15 subchapter with respect to the purchase of such products or with respect to 16 such products produced in vineyards or of other growing facilities in this 17 state belonging to the winery, may make application for grant payments under 18 this subchapter upon forms and in accordance with the rules and regulations 19 promulgated by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration. 20 (b) A public institution of higher education in Arkansas that has a viticulture and enology program may make application for grant payments under 21 22 this subchapter upon form and in accordance with regulations promulgated by 23 the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration. 24 25 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 3-5-907(b), concerning grant payments, are 26 amended to read as follows: 27 (b) Grant funds awarded shall be distributed equally: 28 (1) First to each winery at a base amount not to exceed twentyfive thousand dollars (\$25,000), with any remaining balance of the grant to 29 30 be divided among each grantee according to the same ratio as the wine taxes paid in the previous calendar year by the grantee, as determined by the Chief 31 32 Fiscal Officer of the State rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per gallon of wine 33 sold in Arkansas in the previous calendar year with the total amount of the 34 grant fund not to exceed the total wine tax paid by each winery; and 35 (2) The remaining balance to viticulture and enology programs at 36 public institutions of higher education in Arkansas.

5	There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of		
6	State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State an Arkansas Agricultural		
7	Marketing Grants Fund, into which shall be paid such moneys as may be		
8	provided by law to be used exclusively for making payments of grants to		
9	eligible Arkansas wineries.		
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11	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 19-5-1070(b), concerning the Arkansas		
12	Agricultural Marketing Grants Fund, is amended to read as follows:		
13	(b) This The fund shall consist of such moneys as may be provided by		
14	law, there to be used exclusively for making payments of grants to eligible:		
15	(1) Arkansas wineries with respect to the purchase of grapes,		
16	fruits, berries, or vegetables produced in this state and purchased for use		
17	in this state for the production of wine; and		
18	(2) Viticulture and enology programs at public institutions of		
19	higher education in Arkansas.		
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
