23	SECTION 1. Arkansa	s Code § 20-19-103, is amended to	read as follows:
24	20-19-103. Sterili	zation of impounded dogs and cats.	
25	(a) It shall be un	lawful for any pound, shelter, or i	humane
26	organization, or animal r	<u>escue group</u> supported wholly or pa	rtly by public
27	funds to release any dog	or cat which has not been steriliz	ed to a new owner
28	unless, except as provide	d in subsection $\frac{(e)}{(b)}$ of this se	ction , a promise
29	to spay or neuter the ani	mal has been signed by the person	acquiring the
30	animal.		
31	(b) (1) The steri	lization shall be performed by the	date stipulated,
32	except that the releasing	agency may grant an extension of	time not to exceed
33	thirty (30) days upon the	-request of the owner.	
34	(2) (A) The	signed promise shall be binding,	and failure to
35	comply shall constitute a	violation of this section.	
36	(B) In	such case, the animal described t	herein shall be

1	returned to the releasing agency upon demand. Ownership of the animal reverts		
2	to the releasing agency in such instance. No claim may be made by the owner		
3	to recover expenses incurred for maintenance of the animal, including the		
4	initial procurement cost.		
5	(c)(l) (b)(l) In any county in the state having a population of three		
6	hundred thousand (300,000) or more persons according to the most recent		
7	federal decennial census, it shall be unlawful for any pound, shelter, or		
8	humane organization, or animal rescue group to release to a new owner any dog		
9	or cat over $\frac{1}{1}$ three (3) months of age which has not been sterilized		
10	except as provided in subdivision $\frac{(e)(2)}{(b)(2)}$ of this section.		
11	(2)(A) An animal which in the opinion of a veterinarian license		
12	to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Arkansas is medically		
13	compromised to the extent that it cannot withstand immediate sterilization		
14	may be temporarily released pursuant to a foster care agreement until such		
15	time as it can safely be sterilized or until two (2) veterinarians licensed		
16	to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Arkansas certify that is		
17	unlikely that the animal will ever recover to the extent that it can safely		
18	be sterilized.		
19	(B)(i) At that time, ownership of the animal may be		
20	transferred to an owner who certifies that the animal will not be used for		
21	breeding.		
22	(ii) An owner who violates the agreement shall be		
23	subject to the penalties set forth in subsection $\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{(c)}}$ of this section.		
24	$\frac{(d)(c)}{(d)}$ Violations of this section are declared to be misdemeanors		
25	punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more		
26	than five hundred dollars (\$500).
