19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-28-202 is amended to read as follows:

22	(a) It shall be the duty of the Board of Electrical Examiners of th	.e
23	State of Arkansas to:	
24	(1) Adopt rules and regulations necessary for the implementat	ion

26	(2) At least every six (6) months, conduct examinations of	
27	persons who apply for an electrician's license and grant licenses to

30	inspector's license under § 17-55-101 et seq.; and	
31	(3)(4) Revoke or suspend the license of any licensee or the

8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-28-301(b), concerning the expiration and 9 renewal of electrician's licenses, is amended to add an additional 10 subdivision to read as follows:

23 (a) Any individual licensed or registered under the provisions of this 24 chapter shall not be subject to examination or licensing by any city or 25 county in order to perform electrical work.

26 (b) Any city or town may by ordinance, rules, regulations, or contract 27 prescribe rules, regulations, and standards for the materials used in the 28 construction, installation, and inspection of all electrical work in the city 29 or county, provided the rules, regulations, or standards are not in conflict with the standards prescribed by the Board of Electrical Examiners of the 30 31 State of Arkansas pursuant to under the authority of <u>\$</u> 17-28-202, 17-55-101 et seq., and § 20-31-104. Provided, that a city or county may by 32 ordinance require a person, before doing electrical work on his or her 33 primary residence, to demonstrate a technical competency to comply with the 34 35 city or county standards. If the city has adopted an ordinance to exercise 36 its territorial planning jurisdiction and if the city and county agree to

15	17-55-101. Licensure of electrical inspectors.
16	(a) A person employed as an electrical inspector in the State of
17	Arkansas shall hold an electrical inspector license issued by the Board of
18	Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas.
19	(b)(1) A person shall apply for licensure as an electrical inspector
20	on a form approved by the Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of
21	Arkansas within thirty (30) days of employment as an electrical inspector.
22	(2) Applications shall be made to the board and shall contain:
23	(A) Proof of employment with the state or a political
24	subdivision of the state as an electrical inspector in the State of Arkansas;
25	(B)(i) Verification of work experience as required by rule
26	of the board.
27	(ii) Work experience shall include without
28	limitation demonstrated knowledge of:
29	(a) The standard materials and methods used in
30	the installation of electric equipment;
31	(b) Approved methods of construction to ensure
32	the safety of persons and property; and
33	(c) The requirements of the statewide
34	standards for the construction, installation, and maintenance of electrical

36	the lack of negligence or the exercise of due care by a party at a trial of

2	(b) A person licensed as an electrical inspector under this chapter
3	shall not inspect electrical work that he or she:
4	(1) Installed; or
5	(2) Supervised.
6	(c)(l) Except as provided in subdivisions (c)(2) and (c)(3) of this
7	section, a person licensed as an electrical inspector shall conduct
8	inspections only within the <i>political subdivision</i> employing the inspector.
9	(2) If a person licensed as an electrical inspector is employed
10	by more than one (1) political subdivision, he or she may conduct inspections
11	within any of the <i>political subdivisions</i> employing the person as an
12	electrical inspector.
13	(3) A person employed by the state as an electrical inspector
14	may conduct inspections anywhere within the State of Arkansas.
15	(d) This act shall not prohibit a person licensed as an electrical

22	(a) A person employed as an electrical inspector as of the effective
23	date of this act shall be issued a temporary electrical inspector license
24	upon submission of the following information to the Board of Electrical

26	(1) Proof of employment with the state or a political
27	subdivision of the state as an electrical inspector in the State of Arkansas.
28	(2) Verification of work experience as required by rule of the
29	board; and
30	(3) Payment of a license fee as required by rule of the board.
31	(b)(1) A temporary license issued under this section shall expire on
32	January 1, 2012.
33	(2) A recipient of a temporary license shall be eligible to
34	apply for an electrical inspector license under this section.
