29 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRYOVER 31 OF CLAIMS. Any state agency which is affected by the allowed claim(s) 32 provided for in this Act, and whose fund for the 2010-2011 fiscal year are 33 insufficient to allow for the payment of said claim(s) before June 30, 2011 is hereby authorized, upon certification by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 34 35 State, to make payment of said claim(s) after July 1, 2011, from funds 36 appropriated for the 2011-2012 fiscal year.

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2 SECTION *10.* SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby made 5 the disbursing officer for the purpose of paying the claims appropriated by 6 this Act. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby authorized to 7 receive all warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act from the 8 Auditor of the State and to distribute same to the claimants.

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10 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 12 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act appropriated 13 to the Department of Human Services, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission 14 shall consult with the Department of Human Services and the Chief Fiscal 15 Officer of the State to determine the division and funds to which liability 16 should be assigned and from which the warrants shall be drawn. 20 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 22 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act appropriated to the 23 Department of Health, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall consult 24 with the Department of Health and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to 25 determine the division and funds to which liability should be assigned and from which the warrants shall be drawn. 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30 SECTION *13.* SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS 32 FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined 33 to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds 34 not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 35 notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of 36 such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall

1 forthwith deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who
2 shall deposit the same as a non-revenue receipt into the Miscellaneous
3 Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the
4 claimant.

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6 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission 9 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act 10 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment 11 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an 12 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 13 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and 14 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due 15 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through 16 the State Mechanized Payroll System.

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SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 18 19 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 21 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

1	SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
2	General Assembly, that payees listed in this Act may be entitled to the sums		
3	appropriated and transferred to herein, and that they have been deprived of		
4	the use of these funds for a long period of time, and that further delay in		
5	paying these just debts of the state would do harm to the reputation of the		
6	State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and		
7	this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,		
8	health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date		
9	of its passage and approval.		
10	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
11	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
12	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
13	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides		
14	the veto.
