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29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-7-704(a)(1)(B), concerning eligibility		
30	for disability retirement in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is

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3	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
4	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
5	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are in urgent need of revision to		
6	bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy; that this		
7	revision is of great importance to members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement		
8	System and to other citizens of the State of Arkansas; that the policy of the		
9	system historically has been to calculate deposits and benefits for an		
10	additional fiscal year following the last fiscal year that the member renders		
11	actual service to a covered employer; that the system's policy needs to be		
12	codified into Arkansas law; that this act is necessary in order to maintain		
13	an orderly system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher		
14	Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act		
15	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety		
16	shall become effective on July 1, 2011.		
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
