25	district may not receive isolated funding under this section for an isola	ted
26	school area if the prior year's three-quarter average daily membership of	the
27	isolated school area exceeds three hundred fifty (350).

35	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-20-604(d), concerning special needs

3	(15%) of the foundation funding received by the school district under $\S$ 6-20-
4	2305(a)(2) for the operation of the isolated school areas if the school

7	grade twelve (K-12) in two (2) or more isolated schools meeting the
