## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING FEES COLLECTED FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ARKANSAS HOT CHECK LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

CONCERNING FEES COLLECTED FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ARKANSAS HOT CHECK LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-6-411(b), regarding the fees assessed under the Arkansas Hot Check Law, is amended to read as follows:
(b) A prosecuting attorney may collect a fee from any person issuing a bad check as described in subsection (a) of this section. The amount of the fee shall not exceed:
(1) Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) if the face amount of the check, order, draft, or other form of presentment involving the transmission of account information does not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100);
(2) Thirty dollars ( $\$ 30.00$ ) Forty-five dollars ( $\$ 45.00$ ) if the face amount of the check, order, draft, or other form of presentment involving the transmission of account information is greater than one hundred dollars ( $\$ 100$ ) but does not exceed three hundred dollars ( $\$ 300$ );
(3) Fifty dollars ( $\$ 50.00$ ) Sixty-five dollars $(\$ 65.00)$ if the face amount of the check, order, draft, or other form of presentment involving the transmission of account information is greater than three hundred dollars (\$300) but does not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500); and
(4) Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) Ninety dollars (\$90.00) if the face amount of the check, order, draft, or other form of presentment involving the transmission of account information is greater than five hundred dollars (\$500).
