SENATE BILL 677

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO FULLY FINANCE THE CENTRAL OPERATIONS OF  
9 STATE GOVERNMENT; TO REMEDY FUNDING DISPARITIES  
10 BETWEEN PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE STATE CENTRAL SERVICES  
11 FUND; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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15 TO FULLY FINANCE THE EXPENDITURES AND  
16 OBLIGATIONS OF THE STATE CENTRAL SERVICES  
17 FUND AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-5-205(e)(3) and (4), regarding the State  
24 Central Services Fund, are amended to read as follows:

25 (3)(A) After all other deductions and transfers from other  
26 sources authorized by law have been made available to the State Central  
27 Services Fund, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer ~~such~~  
28 during a fiscal year additional amounts as may be required from the General  
29 Revenue Fund Account to the State Central Services Fund to fully finance the  
30 expenditures and obligations ~~from the appropriations set out in this section.~~

31 (B)(i) The amount of the transfer shall be determined by  
32 subtracting the total of all estimated expenditures from the State Central  
33 Services Fund from the total resources available to the State Central  
34 Services Fund without a transfer of general revenue.

35 (ii) ~~Then the result shall be multiplied by the~~  
36 ~~proportion that the estimated expenditures for the budgets as set out in~~



1 ~~subdivision (e)(3)(C) of this section bears to the total of all the estimated~~  
2 ~~expenditures from the State Central Services Fund~~ To balance the agency  
3 budgets to available funding, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may  
4 enforce budget reductions in each agency that receives funding from the State  
5 Central Services Fund in an amount that each agency's proportionate share of  
6 total estimated expenditures under subdivision (e)(3)(B)(i) of this section  
7 bears to the total estimated expenditures.
