17	(4) Any unexpended and unobligated balance remaining on June 30		
18	of any fiscal year in the State Central Services Fund above five million		
19	dollars (\$5,000,000) shall be transferred to the General Revenue Fund Accoun

22	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
23	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that failure to fully finance the		
24	expenditures and obligations of the State Central Services Fund could work		
25	irreparable harm on the proper administration and provision of essential		
26	government programs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this		
27	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
28	health, and safety shall become effective on:		
29	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
30	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
31	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
32	bill; or		
33	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
34	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
