22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-18-305 is amended to read as follows:  
25 12-18-305. Garrett's Law reports.

26 (a) The Child Abuse Hotline shall accept a report of neglect as  
27 defined under § 12-18-103(13)(B) only if the reporter is one (1) of the  
28 following mandated reporters and the mandated reporter has reasonable cause  
29 to suspect that a child has been subjected to neglect as defined under § 12-  
30 18-103(13)(B):

- 31 (1) A licensed nurse;
- 32 (2) Any medical personnel who may be engaged in the admission,  
33 examination, care, or treatment of persons;
- 34 (3) An osteopath;
- 35 (4) A physician;
- 36 (5) A resident intern;



- (6) A surgeon; or
- (7) A social worker in a hospital.

(b) The Child Abuse Hotline shall accept a report from a physician who reports alcohol use by a pregnant woman who is under twenty-one (21) years of age.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-18-402(19), concerning physicians as mandated reporters under the Child Maltreatment Act, is amended to read as follows:

(19)(A) A physician.

(B) A physician shall also report alcohol use by a pregnant woman who is under twenty-one (21) years of age;
