- 11 (ii) When a general permit includes an expiration
- 12 <u>date earlier than July 1, 2012, the department shall publish the notice of</u>
- 13 <u>intent to renew or not renew the general permit as soon as reasonably</u>

- 15 <u>(B) The department shall publish its final permitting</u>
- 16 decision to renew or not renew the general permit at least one hundred eighty
- 17 (180) days before the expiration date of the general permit.
- 18 (C) If the general permit expires before the final
