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24	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 20-15-603(a), conc	erning the powers and
25	duties of the State Kidney Disease Commission, is amended to read as follows:		
26	(a) The State Kidney Disease Commission shall have the following		
27	functions, powers, and duties:		
28	(1) <u>(A)</u> T	o establish a program to assist	persons suffering from
29	acute or chronic renal failure in obtaining care and treatment requiring

31	<u>(B)</u>	The program shall provide fina	ancial assistance for
32	persons suffering from chronic renal diseases who require life-saving care		
33	and treatment for the renal disease to the extent as determined by the		
34	commission that a person is unable to pay for the services on a continuing		
35	basis without causing unjust and unusual hardship to himself or herself and

- 5 (3) To cooperate with hospitals, private groups, and

- 28 Arkansans in need of kidney transplantation.
