25	(a) The General	Assembly recognizes that all students should have
26	equal access to inters	scholastic activities as a complement to the academic
27	curriculum.	
28	(b) As used in	this section:
29	<u>(1) "Athl</u>	etic activity" means a varsity sport and any activity
30	related to a competiti	ve sports contest, game, event, or exhibition that
31	involves an individual	student or teams of students whether the activity
32	occurs among schools w	vithin the resident school district or between schools
33	outside of the resider	t school district;
34	<u>(2) "Inte</u>	erscholastic activity" means any interschool activity
35	that is outside the re	egular curriculum of a public school district, including
36	without limitation an	athletic activity, a fine arts program, and a special

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1	interest club or group that is subject to regulations of the Arkansas		
2	Activities Association.		
3	(3) "Parent" includes a court-ordered guardian or legal		
4	custodian; and		
5	(4) "Resident school district" means the public school district		
6	in which the home-schooled student's parent or parents reside.		
7	(c)(l) A resident school district may permit a home-schooled student		
8	to participate in an interscholastic activity if the home-schooled student or		
9	his or her parent advises the principal of the school providing the		
10	interscholastic activity in the resident school district in writing of the		
11	student's request to participate in the interscholastic activity within the		
12	first eleven (11) days of the beginning of the school year.		
13	(2) The principal of the school providing the interscholastic		
14	activity in the resident school district shall approve or disapprove the		
15	written request within thirty (30) days of receiving the written request and		
16	any information and documentation requested by the principal.		
17	(3) The decision of the principal of the school providing the		
18	interscholastic activity in the resident school district is final and may not		
19	be appealed.		
20	(d) If a home-schooled student's written request to participate in the		
21	interscholastic activity is approved under subsection (c) of this section,		
22	the student shall then:		
23	(1)(A) Meet the tryout criteria for participation in the		
24	interscholastic activity that apply to students enrolled in the resident		
25	school district.		
26	(B) A home schooled student is not guaranteed		
27	participation in an athletic activity, only the opportunity to tryout for an		
28	athletic activity;		
29	(2)(A) Meet the eligibility criteria for participation in the		
30	interscholastic activity that apply to students enrolled in the resident		
31	school district, including standards of behavior and codes of conduct.		
32	(B) A home-schooled student, the home-schooled student's		
33	parent, and the principal of the school providing the interscholastic		
34	activity in the resident school district shall sign the appropriate standard		
35	of behavior and code of conduct agreements which shall be kept on file in th		
36	resident school district;		

1	(3) Demonstrate educational progress by scoring at grade level		
2	or above on a norm-referenced standardized test in mathematics, English,		
3	science, and social studies each semester that the student participates in an		
4	interscholastic activity;		
5	(4) Comply with all practice times and required drug testing;		
6	(5) Complete any required permissions slips, waivers, and		
7	physical exams; and		
8	(6) Pay any participation or activity fee equal to the fee		
9	charged to students enrolled in the resident school district who participate		
10	in the interscholastic activity.		
11	(e) A home-schooled student who participates in an interscholastic		
12	activity may:		
13	(A) Be counted as an enrolled student by the resident school		
14	district for prorated average daily membership funding purposes; and		
15	(B) Ride to and from interscholastic activity events on a school		
16	bus if that is the policy of the resident school district.		
17	(f) A student who has been enrolled in an Arkansas Activities		
18	Association member school and withdraws from school to be home-schooled shall		
19	not participate in an interscholastic activity in a resident school district		
20	for a minimum of one (1) year after the student withdraws.		
21	(g) A home-schooled student or a parent or guardian of a home-schooled		
22	student who provides or whose parent provides false documentation or		
23	verification of the home-schooled student's qualifications for eligibility to		
24	participate in an interscholastic activity shall be ruled ineligible and		
25	subject to the same penalties as any other student or parent of a student		
26	deemed appropriate by the resident school district.
