1 municipal ordinance, and this section shall not be construed to require a 2 reduction in the level of sick leave below the rate of twenty (20) working 3 days per year or the rate in effect on January 1, 2011. 4 (2)(A) If unused, sick leave shall accumulate to a maximum of sixty (60) days one thousand four hundred forty (1,440) hours unless the city 5 6 or town, by ordinance, authorizes the accumulation of a greater amount, in no 7 event to exceed a maximum accumulation of minety (90) days, except two 8 thousand one hundred sixty (2,160) hours. 9 (B) Unused accumulated sick leave shall not be used for 10 the purpose of computing years of service for retirement purposes. 11 (b)(1) In cities having sick leave provisions through ordinance, the 12 total sick leave accumulated by the individual officer shall be credited to 13 him or her and new days accumulated under the provisions of this section 14 until the maximum prescribed in subsection (a) of this section is reached. 15 (2) If the governing body of the employing municipality successfully reduces the accrual rate, no officer shall have any previously 16 17 earned sick leave reduced in value. 18 (2)(3)(A) Time off may be charged against accumulated sick leave 19 only for such the days that an officer is scheduled to work. No such sick 20 leave as provided in this section shall be charged against any officer during 21 any period of sickness, illness, or injury for any days which the officer is 22 not scheduled to work. 23 (B) If an officer is not scheduled to work, sick leave shall not be charged against him or her during any period of sickness, 24 25 illness, or injury for those unscheduled work days under this chapter. (c) If, at the end of his <u>or her</u> term of service, upon retirement or 26 27 death, whichever occurs first, any police officer has unused accumulated sick 28 leave, he or she shall be paid for this sick leave at the regular rate of pay 29 in effect at the time of retirement or death. Payment for unused sick leave in the case of a police officer, upon retirement or death, shall not exceed 30 31 sixty (60) days salary unless the city, by ordinance, authorizes a greater amount, but in no event to exceed ninety (90) days of salary. 32 (d)(1) Cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and 33 34 incorporated towns shall have the option of providing sick leave for officers to accumulate at a rate of fifteen (15) twenty-four-hour working days per 35 36 year beginning with the date of employment and decreasing to twelve (12)
