Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS AND TEACHERS WHO TEACH STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS AND TEACHERS WHO TEACH STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 7 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-708. Professional Development - Special Education
(a) A teacher shall complete a minimum of eight (8) hours of professional development credit in special education annually if the teacher:
(1) Has a child with a disability in his or her classroom during the current school year; or
(2) Anticipates having a child with a disability in his or her classroom in the year school year following the current school year.
(b) A public school district shall include professional development credit a teacher receives under this section:
(1) In a teachers professional development plan required under § 6-17-704; and
(2) Towards a teachers fulfillment of professional development required by the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and



School Districts as promulgated by the Department of Education.
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
