35	of days a member mus	st be employed to receive service credit,	is amended to
36	read as follows:		

- 1 (2) If an inactive member has not retired and later becomes
  2 reemployed by an employer in a position covered by the system, the person
  3 member shall become an active member and be eligible to accrue additional
  4 service credit.
- 5 (3) If the member's service <u>credit</u> during reemployment is <del>for</del>
  6 less than <del>thirty (30) days</del> <u>one-fourth (1/4) of a fiscal year under § 24-7-</u>
  7 <u>601</u>, he or she shall be considered to be an inactive member at the
  8 termination of the reemployed service, and the only monthly benefits payable shall be those provided by § 24-7-707.
- (4)(A) An active member shall receive credit for any previous unreported service after July 1, 1937, upon paying to the system the member contributions in effect during the previous service, together with interest from the dates of the service to the date of payment in full required payment for the cost of service.
  - (B) For previous service rendered before July 1, 1971, service credit shall be permitted for service in a fiscal school year only if at least one hundred twenty (120) the minimum days of service were rendered is sufficient for one (1) year of service credit under § 24-7-601 in the a fiscal school year.

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- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-7-601(b), concerning the number of days a member must be employed to receive service credit, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 In no case, other than specifically provided otherwise in this 25 subchapter, shall fewer than one hundred twenty (120) days of teaching 26 service rendered in any fiscal school year be credited as one (1) year of 27 service, nor shall more than one (1) year of service be credited any member 28 for all teaching service rendered by him or her in any one (1) fiscal school 29 year (1) A member shall be employed by an employer covered by the Arkansas 30 Teacher Retirement System for a minimum of one hundred sixty (160) days per fiscal year to earn one (1) year of credited service. 31

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34	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 24-7-606(a)(2), concerning the number of

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19	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the
21	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System statutes are urgently in need of revision
22	and updating to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;
23	$\underline{\text{that revision and updating is of great importance to members of the } \text{Arkansas}$
24	Teacher Retirement System and to other citizens of the State of Arkansas;
25	that the school year calendar has historically been expanding with the
26	addition of teacher service requirements and other legislative initiatives
27	while the number of days of service has remained unchanged since the 1970s;
28	that this legislation is necessary to account for the changes in teacher
29	service requirements and to make the retirement system more reflective of the
30	actual number of days of service; and that this act is necessary to maintain
31	an orderly system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher
32	Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act
33	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety
34	shall become effective on July 1, 2011.
