4	(5)(4) "Ordering office" means any state department, independent	
5	establishment, board, commission, bureau, service, or division of state	
6	government and any wholly owned state corporation;	
7	$\frac{(6)}{(5)}$ "Products", for purposes of this subchapter, means	
8	commodities or services wherein the price of the commodities includes at	
9	least twenty percent (20%) value added when the work center is awarded a	
10	contract using the ten percent (10%) preference, and in the case of services,	
11	that they are performed by individuals with disabilities;	
12	(7)(6)(A) "Services" means the furnishing of labor, time, or	
13	effort by a contractor, not involving the delivery of a specific end product	
14	other than reports which are merely incidental to the required performance.	
15	(B) "Services" shall not include employment agreements,	
16	collective bargaining agreements, or architectural or engineering contracts	
17	requiring approval of Arkansas Building Authority;	
18	$\frac{(8)}{(7)}$ "Sheltered workshop" means a work center which has:

- 4 <u>employment to individuals in the State of Arkansas eligible for services from</u>
- 5 the Division of State Services for the Blind:
- 6 (A) As an interim step in the rehabilitation process for
- 7 those who cannot be readily absorbed in the competitive labor market;
- 8 (B) During such time as employment opportunities for
- 9 individuals in the State of Arkansas eligible for service from the Division
- 10 of State Services for the Blind in the competitive labor market do not exist;
- ll or
- 12 <u>(C)</u> For whom such placement represents informed choice as
- 13 appropriate employment at a competitive wage.
- 14 (c) All state agencies as defined in § 19-11-203 are required to
- 15 purchase their requirements of needed available and suitable products and
- 16 purchase suitable services from nonprofit work centers for individuals with
- 17 disabilities, unless such commodities and services are authorized by prior
- 18 legislation for production in another state agency, department, or
- 19 institution.
- 20 (d)(1) The Office of State Procurement shall issue to all state agency
- 21 purchasing agents a schedule of work center made commodities and services
- 22 made by the work center and the conditions under which they are to be
- 23 procured from the workshops.
- 24 (2) The schedule shall include the item or service description.
- 25 (e) Arkansas Rehabilitation Services <u>and the Division of State</u>
- 26 <u>Services for the Blind</u> shall undertake the inspection on a continuing basis
- 27 of the workshops certified by Arkansas Rehabilitation Services each
- 28 respective state agency to determine that they operate in accordance with the
- 29 requirements of the statute and the regulations of this section.
- (f)(1)(A) In order to qualify for participation in the program as a
- 31 work center, an organization shall submit an application to the office
- 32 of State Procurement.
- 33 (B) If required for all vendors, there should be included
- 34 a list of the commodities and services offered for sale to the state.
- 35 (2) Work centers shall:
- 36 (A) Furnish commodities and services in strict accordance

- 1 with the allocation and government order;
- 2 (B) Maintain records of wages paid, hours of employment,
- 3 and sales;
- 4 (C) Make available pertinent books and records of the
- $\underline{\text{state}}$  agency for inspection at any reasonable time to representatives of
- 6 Arkansas Rehabilitation Services or the Division of State Services for the
- 7 Blind, as applicable; and
- 8 (D)(i) Submit to Arkansas Rehabilitation Services or the
- 9 Division of State Services for the Blind, as applicable, by September 1 an
- 10 annual report for the preceding fiscal year.
- ll (ii) This report shall include data on individuals
- 12 with disabilities who are workers, wages and wage supplements, hours of
- 13 employment, sales, whether the workshop requires a facilities sheltered
- 14 workshop certificate from the United States Department of Labor and special
- 15 minimum rates authorized where such certificate is held and such other
- 16 relevant information as may be required.
- 17 (g) When a commodity or service is identified in the schedule of work
- 18 center-made commodities and services as being available through the office
- 19 Office of State Procurement, it shall be obtained in accordance with the
- 20 requisitioning procedures of the supplying state agency.
- 21 (h) An ordering office may purchase from a nonworkshop source
- 22 commodities or services listed in the schedule of work center-made
- 23 commodities and services made by the work center in any of the following
- 24 circumstances:
- 25 (1) Necessity requires delivery within the specified period, and
- 26 the work center cannot give assurance of positive availability;
- 27 (2) When commodities listed on the schedule of work center-made
- 28 commodities can be purchased from a nonwork center non-work-center source by
- 29 the state agency for a price more than ten percent (10%) lower than work
- 30 center-made commodities made by the work center included in the schedule; or
- 31 (3) Services offered by any work center shall be procured by any
- 32 state agency in accordance with this section at a price not more than ten
- 33 percent (10%) above the lowest price submitted from a nonwork center non-
- 34 work-center source.
- 35 (i) Work center-made product Product commodities made by a work center
- 36 will shall be delivered in accordance with the terms of the purchase order.

- (j) When a workshop fails to comply with the terms of a government order, the ordering office shall make reasonable efforts to negotiate an adjustment before taking action to cancel the order.
- (k) Any alleged violation of these regulations shall be investigated by the office Office of State Procurement, which shall notify the work center concerned and afford it an opportunity to submit a statement of facts and evidence.
