6	days have elapsed after the travel or after the state-owned vehicle was at		
7	the location.		
8	(d) The records kept by a state agency, board, or commission under		
9	this section are subject to audit by the Division of Legislative Audit and		
10	shall be kept for at least five (5) years.		
11	(e) Each state agency, board, or commission that uses global		
12	positioning devices on its vehicles may promulgate rules for the		
13	implementation and administration of this section.
